

Extra Equipment for Cabin Trips Checklist

The following equipment is required on trips based out of a typical road-accessible cabin in New England, *in addition to* the ordinary hiking gear (other lists). Contact the trip leader to discuss requirements. When sharing living quarters with others, it is helpful to mark your clothing and gear with your name or colored cord to help sort out everything.

For all cabins

- ◆ **Sleeping bag** warm down to +40F
- ◆ **Pillow** or stuff sack filled with clothes
- ◆ Indoor **soft shoes** or booties
- ◆ **Flashlight** for night-time business
- ◆ **Towel**, personal toiletries
- ◆ **Quarters** for coin-op showers near some facilities
- ◆ **Earplugs** in case of snoring (names removed to protect the guilty)
- ◆ Travel **alarm** clock
- ◆ Set of **dry clothes** for evenings
- ◆ **Backpack** or duffel bag to carry gear
- ◆ **Stuff sacks** to organize gear

For some cabins

- ◆ a soft **sleeping pad**
