PROGRAM UPDATES

General Discussion

Philosophy - to provide a service to members. Chapter feels "programs" are valuable and would support HB in any potential deficits/shortfalls.

For consideration - We can ask the chapter to purchase the AMC Guides which would provide a greater surplus to the committee.

Recommendation was made to keep a balance in the Committee account that would provide timely reimbursement to members who pay out of pocket for expenses.

Scholarships - these have been available on an ad hoc/as requested basis.

Spring Hiking Program

Approved Member & Non Member fees for 2016 SHP, in line with the current \$40/\$70 WHP pricing. While operations at that revenue level are not sustainable over time, the committee resolved to finish 2016 as is, and then use the results of the full year as the basis for deciding on pricing for the next WHP and onward. If we decide that the \$30 differential is working well, we can continue with it, but with an increased base amount should the committee conclude that we need to garner additional revenue.

New role: Outdoor Community Liaison

Jeff expressed concern that the "Outdoor Community Liaison Role" at a sub-committee level assumes an autonomy sub committees don't currently have. Outreach is done at the club level. Relationships with outside entities could blur boundaries between initiatives "Club" and/or Chapter may be cultivating. For example committee cannot develop its own advertising initiatives without the approval of Club/Chapter. This role might be better served at the chapter level. Discussion deferred until Alex can be present.

<u>3-season gear lists</u> - Stephen is looking for feedback in preparation for a vote to adopt at December meeting. He will also circulate draft versions of the 4-season lists ahead of the meeting so that the committee can discuss both.

Projects and Status

<u>Website content maintenance project</u> - volunteer has been identified to assist with the migration

Capturing participant complaints - Casey will send link to form for feedback

<u>Leadership mentor feedback form</u> - draft will be resubmitted to committee to review. Focus is on the areas we want feedback on, and the actual questions.

Leadership applications from experienced leaders from other committees

Discussion - rules permit us to approve leadership status to applicants who have the required experience but have not participated in HB Leadership program and/or the three required coleads. Considerations: Should they have REGI training? How many current co-leads should they be required to have? How many recommendations/referrals should we require? Do we recognize the leadership training received through other committees? The consensus was that the committee should continue to handle these on a case by case basis.

Jeff offered that he perceives the NH Chapter to have the most difficult leadership approval process. In MA, HB has the most difficult approval process.
