Operational Updates

Executive Committee - Paul Terenzi

The executive committee voted to accept the AMC staff run Young Members Leadership Training program as equivalent to the program run by the Boston Chapter. This year the YM training will be held in New York state in the Fall. Depending on how the program goes, it may be offered again in the future.

The New Member social had over 230 attendees. There were representatives from most of the activity groups to speak with the new members. Paul reported around 170 attendees stopped by the Hiking/Backpacking table. HB representatives handed out flyers with hiking tips and AMC contact information. The committee expressed interest in ensuring that all activity groups are as well prepared as HB for coming events.

The exec committee has requested that all activity committees submit budgets for 2017 no later than early November. Budgets should be sent to the chapter treasurer, Michael Swartz.

Jeff Carlson reported that Joy Street has responded to the feedback around the new "Audience" field in the ActDB trip listings. The field will no longer be mandatory, and HB is encouraged to specify "Adults 18 +". Volunteer lead trips will have the option to set their audience to either "20's and 30's" or "Families." These field should only be used when the intention of the trip is to have an overwhelming majority of participants fall into one of these specific categories. Otherwise the trips will be listed as "Adults 18+".

Leadership Application Process Enhancement - Pam Wilmot

The larger conversation has been tabled until the September meeting. The sub committee needs to meet and put together a proposal. A key item for the sub committee to address is the development of a feedback mechanism that would allow leaders to provide co-leaders with feedback immediately following the trip.

Leadership Requirements - Stephen Conlin

There was considerable discussion around the proposed policy and updates to the leadership requirements.

The proposed policy was approved with three changes

- 1. Applicants for three season leadership must complete a minimum of four (instead of three) co-leads
- 2. Three (instead of two) of the four co-leads must take place within the 12 months prior to the application date
- 3. The co-leads must be completed with a minimum of three different leaders

The new policy will be communicated to all leaders and co-leaders.

Summer Leader Appreciation Outing - Paul Terenzi

Not enough interest was expressed in arranging an outing for this summer. A fall gathering was proposed, to be discussed by a sub committee and addressed at the September meeting.
