The Club is changing the timing for budgets; need to submit the final budget to Club by December 1; Need to submit from the Committee to the Chapter on October 25th

Preliminary Budget review October 1, so will need to vote on budget in October meeting, and review it in September

PRH: Checks \$11,450; Paypal: \$5,674.47; Total \$17,124.47 Paypal Fees \$135.49 Will run about even; pending final review of the expense form (ACCURATE?)

Will do leader survey to assess availability and interest and allow planning for group size.

Will need to start planning for new coordinator

Initial feedback from last year's participants indicates that people missed the in-person experience. Could consider a hybrid or partial in-person-- or sign up for either in person or online versions. Will look at whether there will be any special access for last year's participants due to MA-travel restrictions.

May consider City Square, as cost is low and program size is likely to be small. May look for new location for future programs.

Cardigan - will need to decide if it will be possible. ACTION; Chris will check with reservations.

5. REGI

Need to look at where we are pulling leader application information from.

Only advantage to ActDB is the virtual waiver and one-stop-shop

May be moving to a new system rather than ActDB; will we need to accommodate it?

Put Co leaders in CL spots, L in L spots; will keep track of how many requests for CL screening we receive.
